TEAM SIDELINE APP: We highly encourage you to download the team sideline app! When your child's schedule is made, once logged in with your evansyouthbaseball.com account your child's schedule will immediately transfer to your phone calendar! You just have to click "publish" to link it to your calendar. This is extremely useful and saves a lot of time. You also will have a calendar on the app to see any changes or reschedules!

Opening Day: Opening day is May 9th! 9AM. We will have our parade around the complex with each team's banner! We always look forward to seeing your creativity! Each player will meet their team along the fence - we will have signs directing you where your team will meet.

Team Parent: The team parent will assist the coach with communication, if needed, and helps to keep order in the dugout for the safety of all players.

Banners: Each team is responsible for a banner that will be carried by your team on opening day and presented to a panel of judges. Following opening day this banner will hang in your dugout for each game. Banners should **include your team's name (your team's choice!), sponsor name, players names, coaches names, and division (T-ball, Minor, etc.). Prizes will be awarded for the winning banners! Typically the team parent will take the lead on this. Coaches have been provided with any information that you will need to go on the banners.**

Food Allergies: Please communicate with your coach if your child has any allergies. We forwarded them anything that you placed on your registration but a reminder is always appreciated.

Team Photos: Bonnie's Photo Imagery does our photos. Teams will be scheduled for a photo day. Each child is photographed individually, coaches too! They are then made into a team composite.

Rain Outs: Rain outs will be communicated through your coaches, via email, Facebook and our Remind app. We will get the information out as soon as possible! If we can make the fields playable with our WNY rain, we will. We always welcome help to do so! Sometimes raking a field before the rain falls or after can make the difference of a playable field.
